Principal's Message



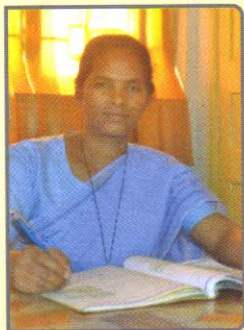

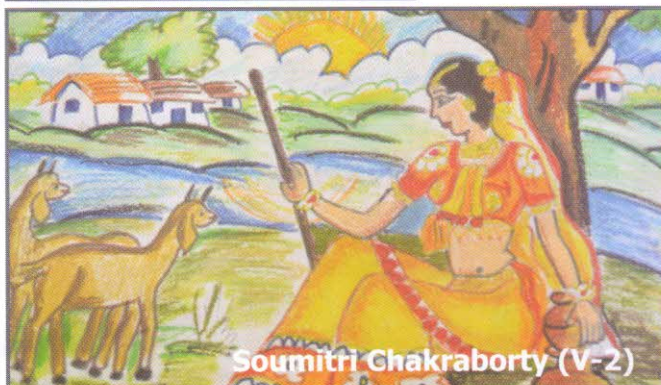

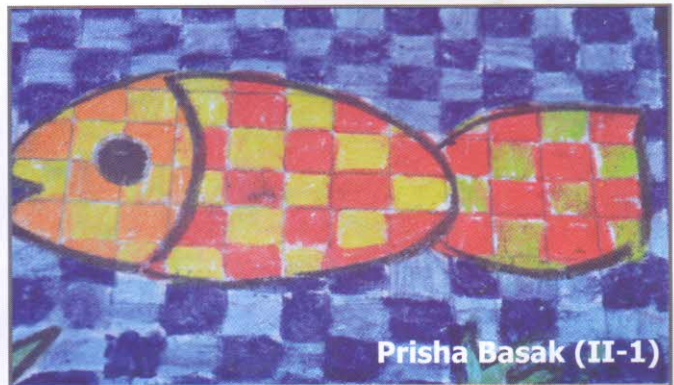

Review of 'EK VILLAIN'

'Ek Villain' is the Hindi remake of a South Korean thriller — 'I saw the Devil'. The film can be slotted in the same category as Mohit Suri's earlier film 'Murder 2'. But the makers tried to customise it for the family audience, hence they chopped off murder and gore and added all the masala ingredients. The film could have ended by interval. The latter half looks confusing and mixed up. High voltage drama is deliberately pitched in every third scene. The actors, Siddharth Malhotra and Sraddha Kapoor, tried hard to fit into their characters. Riteish Deshmukh plays a very interesting and mysterious role in the film. The first thing which stands apart is the track 'Teri Galiyan'. Siddharth Malhotra looks excellent in the film as the angry young man. Sraddha Kapoor as the bubbly girl takes your heart away. 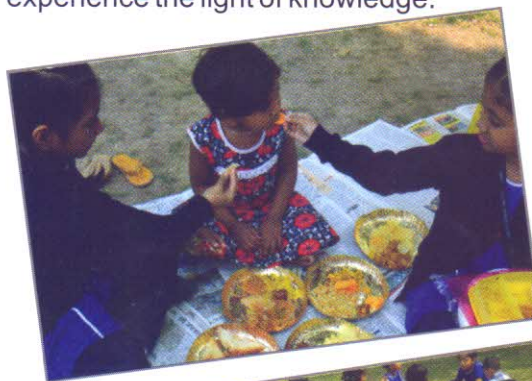
Madanlal is a driver. He aspires that his intelligent daughter, Jamuna, will one day become a successful doctor and help those people who cannot afford medical attention.
